

Where do you arrive?	What to do?
Schiphol airport	Take a direct train to Amsterdam central station. This will cost you 3,70 euro and will take 15-20 minutes. The train station is right underneath the airport. From Amsterdam Central station take the metro line 51, 53 or 54 to Weesperplein, this is the third stop.
Düsseldorf Weeze Airport	Take a cab to Nijmegen central station. Direct trains run to Amsterdam central station twice an hour. This ride will cost you 16,80 euro. From Amsterdam Central station take the metro line 51, 53 or 54 to Weesperplein, this is the third stop.
Eindhoven Airport	Take a bus to Eindhoven central station. Direct trains run to Amsterdam Amstel station twice an hour. This ride will cost you 16,90 euro. From Amstel take metro line 51, 53 or 54 (direction central station) to Weesperplein, this is the second stop.
Amsterdam Amstel Station (Eurolines coach)	Take metro line 51, 53 or 54 (direction central station) to Weesperplein, this is the second stop.
Travelling by car?	It's easy to find parking space in Amsterdam but it's really expensive (up to 6 euro's an hour!) There are a number of 'Park & Rides' where you can leave your car for only 6 euro/24 hours. All of them have public transport connections to the city centre.
